This means that the fourth tank is shut off and held as a reserve. Although we are on auto delivery of gas, you may run out of gas due to unexpected use. If this occurs, open the forth tank and relight all the pilot lights then call the gas company for a delivery.

Remember that Opening Day weekend starts on Thursday, June 11. We hope to see everyone along with our visiting clubs for another spectacular start to the 2009 boating season.

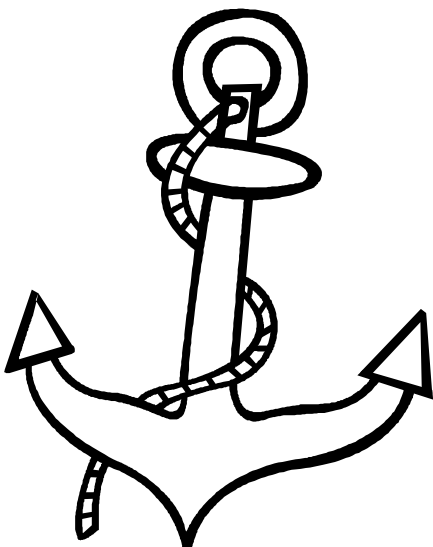

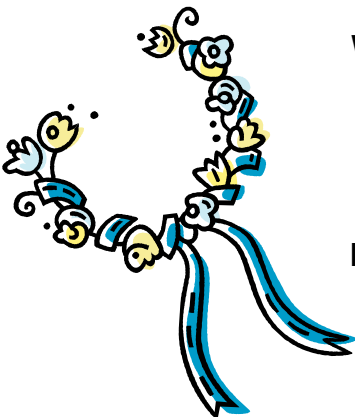
