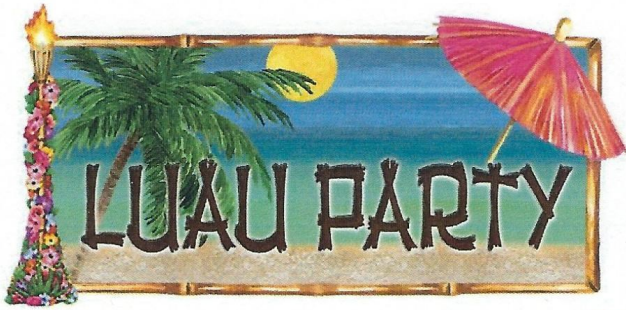

Lastly I again want to thank all of you for your encouragement and support that provide. I definitely feel blessed to be surrounded by so many great people. EYC Rocks!!!

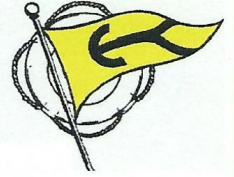

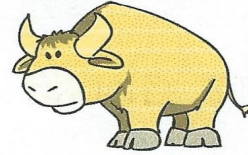

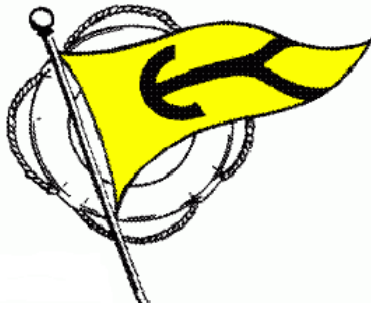
