I hope you all stay safe, happy and healthy. Thank you!



### VEHICLE AND PARKING RULES

Member name and slip \_\_\_\_\_

1. All cars and vehicles shall be parked on the parking lot in an orderly manner.
2. House trailers will not be permitted to park in the premises overnight.
3. Campers and Mobile Homes may not be left on the premises unoccupied. Fees comparable to those charged for docking will be charged for those vehicles when on the premises. Campers and mobile homes will only be parked in areas designated by the Board of Governors.
4. Boats on trailers or trailers may not be stored on the grounds.
5. Vehicles to be kept off grass areas unless necessary to perform jobs and then only when ground is dry so that minimum damage will result from vehicle on grass.
6. All vehicles must be operated at reasonable speeds and care while on premises, 5 m.p.h. in pier area.
7. Parking on the pier area parking lot is for slip holders ONLY - One vehicle per slip.

#### A FINE OF \$25.00 WILL BE IMPOSED ON

##### EACH MEMBER IF:

- A. Member parks two (2) vehicles on lot (holding only one slip).
- B. Member's guest parks on lot.
- C. A member who is not a slip holder parks on lot.

Members are responsible for their guests adhering to the EYC rules while on EYC property.


