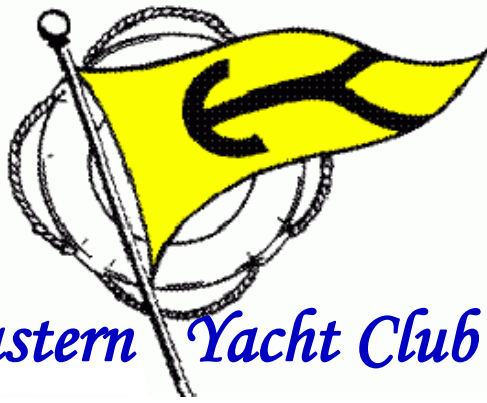

Hello EYC friends,

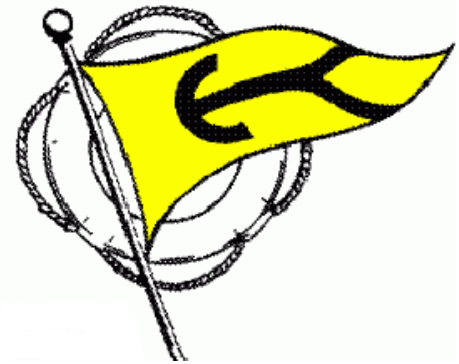

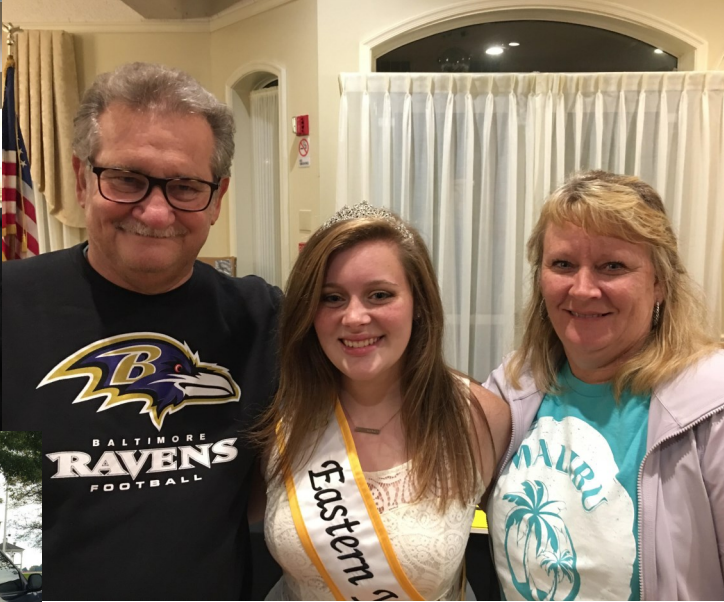

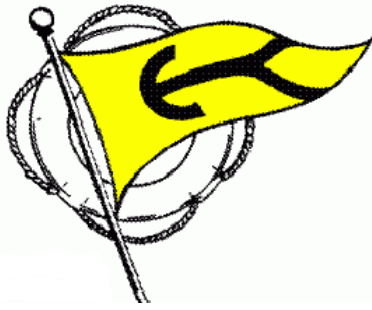
