Pasta e Fagioli (Soup Served Italian Night)

Ingredients

2 tbsp. of olive oil 8 oz. Italian sausage 4 oz. hot, 4 oz. sweet (casings removed)

2 large cloves of garlic (or 1 teaspoon minced garlic)

2 cups of water 1 - 15 oz. can fat free salt less chicken broth

1 -14.5oz. Can of diced tomato with garlic, basil and oregano

2 – Tablespoons of tomato paste 1 - Cup of uncooked ditalini pasta

¹/₄ teaspoon salt 1 teaspoon dried Italian seasoning

1/4 teaspoon fresh ground pepper 1/4 teaspoon crushed red pepper flakes

 $1-15\ \text{oz.}$ can white kidney beans (drained)

1 - 15 oz. can green beans –drained-chopped (drained)





Heat oil in large Dutch oven; Add garlic and sausage. When sausage begins to brown add water, broth, cans of tomatoes; bring to a boil. Stir in pasta, Italian seasoning, salt, pepper, red pepper flakes, white beans, and chopped green beans. Bring to a boil, cover, reduce heat simmer 8 minutes or until pasta is done. (I simmer for 2 hours)


