

### GBMC NICU Story

GBMMC is an independent, community hospital located in Towarm that has \$22 beds and has over 100,000 patient visits per year. GMBC is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization, one of the only community hospital that remains in the greater Baltimore/Washington area. As a non-profit GBMC relies heavily on financial supposet from the community.

The Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) at GBMC is a state of the art facility that provides comprehensive care for newborns regardless of gestational age or birthweight. The recently renovated NICU has 13 rooms and 23 beds. The NICU is staffed with highly trained doctors and nurses who provide around the clock care for the babies until they are healthy enough to go home. GBMC delivers more than 4,000 babies each year, but nearly 1 in 10 of them go into the NICU, some for a few hours, some for many weeks.

Donations and grants are in high demand to provide items and services that are not covered by insurance, especially as GBMC lives out its mission: To every patient, every time, we will provide the care that we would want for our own loved ones. These include items not only for the babies, but the parents, too. Some of these awesome items include "beads of courage" in which the baby gets a bead for each major hurtle jumped or milestone made, eventually turning into a keepsake necklace mapping out the baby's journey. Another are Kangaroo chairs in which parent and baby can cuddle with skin to skin contact to provide a physical bond that helps the baby's development and reduce parent's stress. Money is used to pay for sit-in parents to watch over and care for a baby whose parents cannot be at the NICU all the time. Siblings, too young to enter the NICU, are also provided with care and supervision while parents visit their newborn. There's also the medical side, money to provide fortified nutritional milk that is expensive and in high demand, but low in volume. There's equipment upkeep and the list goes on.

The GMBC NICU does amazing work, bringing newborn babies with unimaginable challenges to good health and are able to thrive and grow. To continue to provide these services and to keep advancing with technology and facing the challenges of this world, GBMC NICU needs your donations.
