

Hello everyone:


Well I don't know about you guys but I have had enough of this cold weather. But it won't be long until spring, about 3 weeks and the club will start to come back to life!

S/P procedure to repair cardiac condition. Doing well. She will require close follow -up for the next 6 months as healing takes place. Keep her in your thoughts and prayers.




