DSC What is it? Digital Selective Calling (DSC) is an automated calling system that is part of the Global Maritime Distress and Safety System (GMDSS).

To take advantage of GMDSS, you must have a VHF-FM radio that incorporates DSC. To use automated distress calling, your transmitter must have a unique identity, a Maritime Mobile Service Identity (MMSI) that is registered with the search and rescue database. During an emergency pushing a button will automatically transmit a May Day call which includes the MMSI number (and location if the radio is linked to a GPS receiver) to every DSC radio within range, approximately 20nm. When the US Coast Guard receives a distress alert with the unique MMSI number, it will use the information on file (emergency contact number, type of vessel, etc.) to mount a more effective rescue effort. MMSI numbers can be obtained from Boat U.S. at no charge.


