Our next big event is not until the Crab Feast in September.

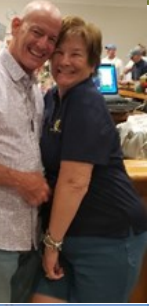

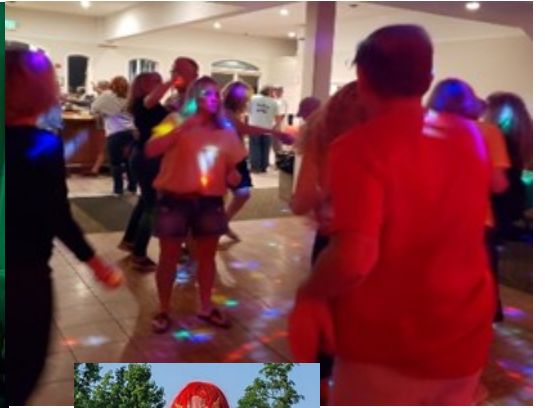

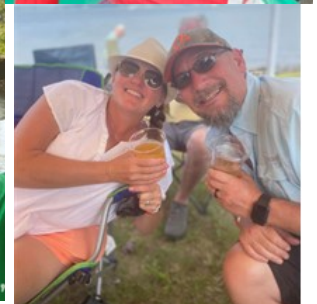
