



Slip Bidding Process

This process applies to New or Regular Members wanting to bid on a new permanent slip or to change a present slip.

Prior to "Slip Night" a diagram of the yacht basin is posted in Tiki Bar identifying all available slips along with a seniority list.

The bidding is open and under control of RC. The member with the most seniority will win any individual bid for a slip.

The RC will request the member with the lowest **seniority number** to choose a slip, from available slips, or remain in their current permanent slip.

If a slip becomes open due to a member bidding on a new slip, anyone with more seniority who may have already passed by reaming in their current permanent <u>slip</u>, <u>or</u> bid on another slip may now bid on the newly open slip. This will <u>allow by</u> <u>seniority</u> members to bid on any slip that becomes available.

Each Member takes FULL responsibility that the slip bid on will accommodate the member's boat. If found to be out of compliance after slip night, a temporary slip will be assigned if available, and the member will be eligible to bid on a new slip the following year.

After successfully bidding on a slip, the member MUST be prepared to pay for the slip IN FULL at the conclusion of the bidding. The check for the full amount of the annual slip rental along with the slip agreement and proof of insurance are to be given to the Treasurer or the Treasurer's designate before the slip assignment is official.

There is also a one time \$100.00 maintenance fee for all new members due on slip night.

The member must notify the electric company immediately following slip day to transfer the electric to the members name and home address.

First time slip owners are to set up a date/time for boat inspection with the RC or FC if the boat has not been inspected.

Just a reminder that we are in our summer schedule for the lower **parking lot**.
